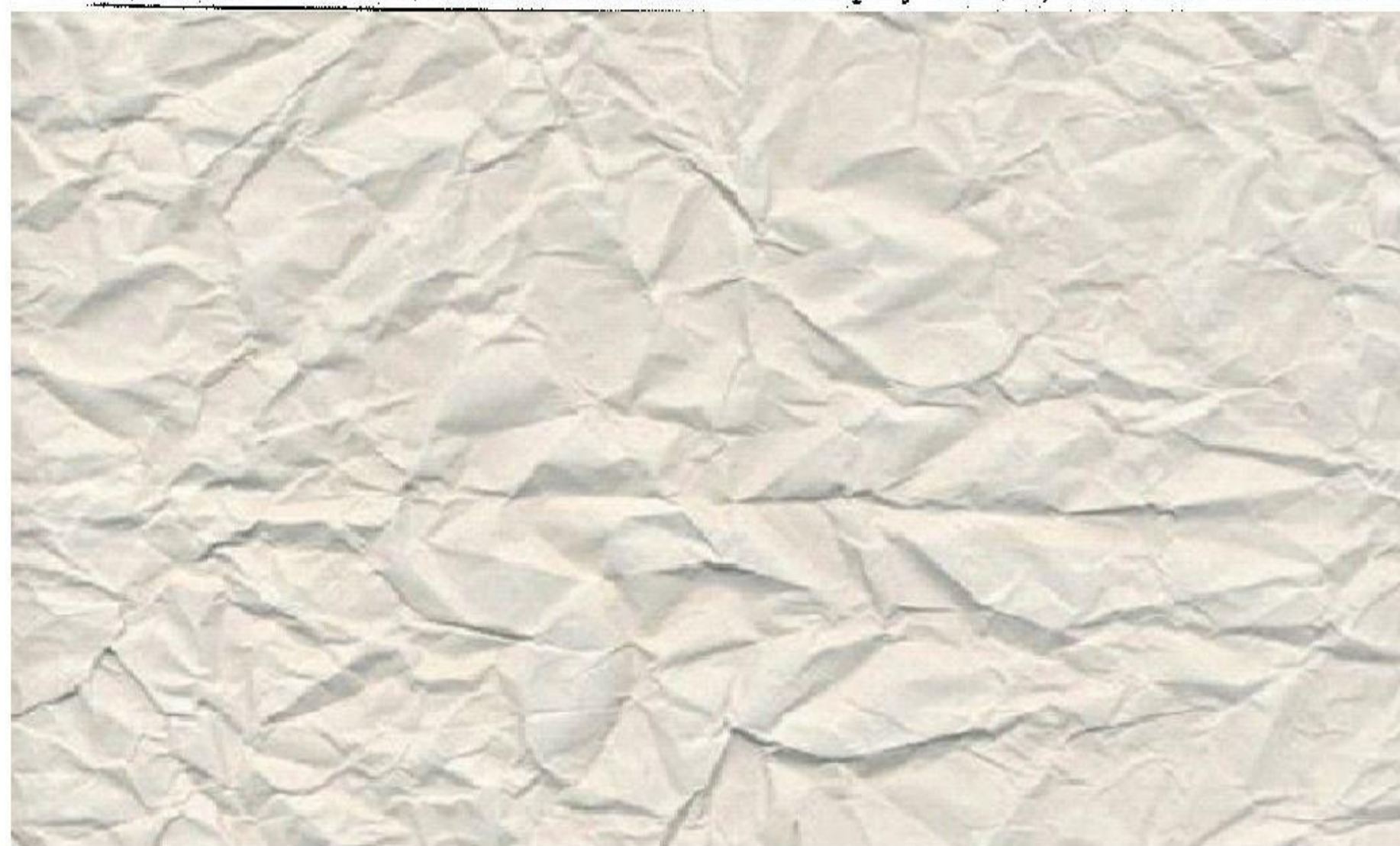


Oil & gas firm donates classrooms to Delta community

To help provide serene learning environment in its host community, partnership with SunTrust recently built and donated a set of 12 classrooms to Utagba-Ogbe Grammar School, Kwale, Delta State.



Utahba-Ogbe, Kwale is one of the host communities where the firm has been operating for eight years. As part of its resolve to improve living condition in the community, the company, every year executes major and significant people-oriented projects in the host communities. It had built and equipped a modern hospital ward at the Kwale General hospital, which it handed over to the hospital's management board, last year, as well as tarring and expanding a major street in the community.

Speaking at the commissioning ceremony, the Managing Director of Midwestern Oil and Gas company, Mr. Charles Oditah, an engineer, noted that the classroom project is in pursuit of the company's commitment to contributing to the socio-economic development of its host communities via improved access to education amongst other things. Oditah noted that the company constructed the 12 classrooms using the services of two indigenous contractors while all materials and labour were also sourced from the community.
